

- Action 3.5 Manage information for analysis, decisionmaking and reporting
- ✓ Action 3.6 Provide support, assist and cooperate
- ✓ Action 3.7 Apply practice development
- ✓ Action 3.8 Promote and expand cooperation

PROGRESS TO DATE IN AFRICA





- ✓ Total of 3 States parties in Africa have reported to have complied with their Article 4 obligations
- ✓ 1 Signatory State is reported to have completed clearance of cluster munitions in contaminated areas
- ✓ 1 States Parties have still have outstanding deadlines
- 2 Signatory States Parties have reported to have contamination while 3 Non State Parties are reported to be contaminated

RECOMMENDATIONS



- 1. **Timely Reporting** *qualitative, quantitative*
- **2. Resource mobilization** mobilise financial, technical, legal, material
- 3. Enhance cooperation bilateral, multilateral, sub-regional, regional and global levels
- 4. Increased coordination-focal points
