Received technical and financial assistance from UNMAS to fulfil Article 3 obligations from January to February 2013

Initial transparency report submitted on 29 April 2013

Annual reports submitted covering: 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2019, and 2020

#### **Article 9 - National implementation measures**

Côte d'Ivoire has existing laws that regulate weapons and ammunition; it has however expressed intention to undertake legal measures to implement the CCM (since 2013)
